

## The Financial Implications of Buying 8 Homewood Court, Cedars Village, Chorleywood, Hertfordshire, WD3 5GB

Set out below are worked examples of the financial implications of buying the above property. Created on 6/4/2021.

**Note: These worked examples are for guidance only. Please discuss your individual circumstances and financial commitments with your solicitor, other legal or financial adviser.**

This illustration is not a forecast and, like any other investment, the value of properties in the village could go down as well as up.

### **EXAMPLE 1: TYPICAL ANNUAL COSTS**

This first example deals with the potential annual costs of buying a retirement property. **It excludes:**

- The cost of any **mortgage** you may have, and;
- The **personal monthly bills** for which you would be liable, such as council tax, electricity, gas, water, telephone rates and charges, (if applicable), contents insurance, television licence, broadband / satellite / cable subscriptions and any other bills.

The costs shown are based upon the purchase cost and service charge costs for single or double occupancy of a 2 bedroom Ground Floor Apartment, address 8 Homewood Court, Cedars Village, Chorleywood, Hertfordshire, WD3 5GB, purchased for **£365,000 (Three Hundred and Sixty-Five Thousand Pounds)**.

As a leasehold owner, you will be responsible for the following costs, which are applicable from: Oct 2020 to Sep 2021 and annually thereafter.

Costs	Calculation Method	Annual Cost
<b>Service Charge *</b>	Monthly £516	£6,196.00
Total (double occupancy) additional cost per annum if applicable	Monthly £25.00	£300.00
<b>Ground Rent</b>	Monthly £20.83	£250
	<b>Monthly £562.17</b>	<b>£6,746.00</b>

\*The service charge is reviewed every year in consultation with residents.

### **EXAMPLE 2: A SALE (Otherwise known as assignment) of your property**

This second example deals with some of the one-off costs if you were to sell (otherwise known as to “assign”) your property. **It excludes:**

- Any outstanding **ground rent** or **service charge** that you owe;
- Any **mortgage costs**, including the cost of paying off (sometimes referred to as redeeming) your mortgage;
- The costs of any **solicitor**, conveyancer or legal adviser you appoint to deal with the sale/assignment;
- Any **estate agents fees**; (Inclusive if using RV PROPERTY HOLDINGS LTD re-sales service)
- Any **tax** which you may have to pay, including stamp duty;
- Any **costs of moving**;
- The **cost of ensuring the property is in good decorative order prior to the resale.**

***The assignment fee, which is payable to the landlord, RV PROPERTY HOLDINGS LTD, provides a return on the original investment in developing the communal facilities in the Village. It does not contribute towards the costs of any services that are provided or to a sinking fund and accordingly is not held in trust for residents***

If you purchase the property for £365,000 and in the future sell/assign it for the sale prices below, examples of the corresponding assignment fees incurred on the sale/assignment of the property are indicated underneath the sale prices:-

**The proportion of the sales price payable does not change over time: it is 10% whenever a property is sold.**

FEE	Calculation Method	Cost
<b>EXAMPLE A: If you sell the property after 6 years and the property has <u>not changed</u> in value</b>		
Sale Price		£365,000
The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	10% of the sale price	£36,500 Payable when you sell OR

<b>EXAMPLE B: If you sell the property after 6 years and the property has increased in value by 3% per annum.</b>		
Sale Price		£435,829
The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	10% of the sale price	£43,583 Payable when you sell OR

<b>EXAMPLE C: If you sell the property after 6 years and the property has decreased in value by 3% per annum.</b>		
Sale Price		£304,035
The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	10% of the sale price	£30,404 Payable when you sell OR

<b>EXAMPLE D: If you sell the property within 2 years and the property has increased in value by 3% per annum.</b>		
Sale Price		£387,228
The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	10% of the sale price	£38,723 Payable when you sell OR

FEE	Calculation Method	Cost
<b>EXAMPLE E: If you sell the property within 2 years and the property has decreased in value by 3% per annum.</b>		
Sale Price		£343,428
The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	10% of the sale price	£34,343 Payable when you sell OR

<b>EXAMPLE F: If you sell the property within 1 year and the property has increased in value by 3% per annum.</b>		
Sale Price		£375,950
The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	10% of the sale price	£37,595 Payable when you sell OR

<b>EXAMPLE G: If you sell the property within 1 year and the property has decreased in value by 3% per annum.</b>		
Sale Price		£354,050
The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	10% of the sale price	£35,405 Payable when you sell OR
